1. Quality Food

- a. School Food Trays
 - i. All components are present on tray
 - ii. Correct serving portion on the tray
 - iii. Check the details

2. Lighting

- a. Natural lighting is best
- b. Bright colors show up best on trays
- c. Include a variety of colors for contrast
- d. Check the details

3. Background

- a. Check what is around you
- b. Remove any distractions
 - i. Trashcans
 - ii. Lunchboxes
 - iii. Unsightly equipment, etc.
- c. Create a better background
- d. Check the details

4. People

- a. Ensure if there are people in food pictures you have permission to use their photo
- b. Showcase your happy customers
- c. Check the details

5. Information

- a. Submit name of school and school district
- b. Name of manager and Director/Supervisor
- c. Identify any other people included in the photos
- d. Short description of photo(s)

6. Sharing pictures on social media platforms
